

APPROVED MEDICATIONS IN PREGNANCY

While it is best to avoid any exposure to medications in pregnancy, there are times when the benefits of treatment outweigh the risks, especially with medications whose risk are minimal. The following medications are generally permitted in pregnancy unless you have an allergy or known problem with the medication. Follow package directions unless otherwise instructed by your healthcare provider.

HEADACHES: Extra Strength Tylenol

Tylenol PM

BODY ACHES: Extra Strength Tylenol

Tylenol PM

NASAL OR HEAD Sudafed (pseudoephedrine hydrochloride) Do not use if

CONGESTION: you have high blood pressure.

Tylenol Sinus. These may help congestion and sinus

pressure headaches by decongesting.

Afrin Nasal Spray (do not use if you have high blood

pressure).

ALLERGY Actifed (which has Sudafed in it, so don't take with

SYMPTOMS-WATERY, Sudafed)

ITCHY EYES, RUNNY NOSE: **Chlor-trimeton** (chlorpheniramine maleate),

Claritin and Claritin D are also OK. These are

antihistamines. Do NOT use cold or allergy preparations with multiple ingredients. Saline nasal drops are safe to

use.

COUGH: Robitussin

Robitussin DM

SORE THROAT: If sore throat lasts longer than 48 hours and/or is

accompanied by fever of 101 or higher, you should be seen for a throat culture in the office. Warm salt water gargles (½ teaspoon salt in 8oz. warm water) can be used

every few hours. Do not swallow the solution. **Chloraseptic** spray may be used as directed.

DIARRHEA: Immodium. If diarrhea persists or is accompanied

by cramping or pain, please call your healthcare

provider.

NAUSEA: Unisom

Dramamine Benadryl Emetrol

Vitamin B6 25 mg twice a day.

If you are unable to keep fluids down for 24 hours,

contact the office.

INDIGESTION: Mylanta

Maalox Tums

Riopan (this one is low in sodium)

Zantac 75 Pepcid HC Tagamet

HEMORRHOIDS: Preparation H

Preparation H with hydrocortisone

Anusol HC Tucks pads.

CONSTIPATION: Milk of Magnesia

VAGINAL YEAST INFECTION: Monistat
